# Pre-Teen Childcare & Pre-Teen Drop-In Programs

As of August 30, 2023 we will be offering programs for pre-teens in grades K-7 (up to age 12). Care will be available in the morning (AM), afternoon (PM), or a combination (AM/PM) of both depending on family needs.

  - o Program Hours of Operation: Monday-Friday 6:30am-9am and 2:30-6:30pm
  - o Location: Boys & Girls Club of Pawtucket, One Moeller Place, Pawtucket, RI



- Member Grouping: Youth members will be grouped together by their grade and will have autonomy to choose activities throughout the day using an activity menu. Grade level groups are listed below.
  - Kindergarten
  - Grades 1-2
  - Grades 3-4
  - Grades 5-7
- Activities include but are not limited to homework help, gym, art, music, dance, STEM, and swim.
- o A healthy meal will be provided to all participants during the PM hours.

# ARE PROGRAMS AVAILABLE FOR SCHOOL VACATION WEEKS?

Vacation week programming is available and will require a separate registration and additional fee. The vacation week program fee is \$160/member and DHS childcare subsidies are also accepted. During the weeks listed below, the Club will have extended full day hours available for care.

- April Vacation- 4/15/2024-4/19/2024

### ARE MASKS REQUIRED IN THE FACILITY?

# **Grades 1-7 (up to age 12)-Including Transportation**

- AM Care- \$60
- PM Care- \$110
- AM & PM Care- \$165
- Fees are weekly

# K-7 Drop-In Members- Excludes Transportation

- PM Care- Covered by Annual Youth Membership
- \$50-Pawtucket & Central Falls Residents
- \$70-All other cities

All registrants will be set up for *auto-pay* upon registration. Failure to pay a balance on time will result in a delay of your child's start date.

  - Location: Boys & Girls Club of Pawtucket, One Moeller Place, Pawtucket, RI
  - Member Grouping: Youth members will have autonomy to choose activities throughout the day and all ages will have access to each activity.
  - Activities include but are not limited to homework help, gym, art, music, dance, STEM, workforce development, financial literacy, and swim.

# IS TRANSPORTATION AVAILABLE FOR TEEN PROGRAMS?

Transportation may be available for Teens after 4pm. Transportation availability is based on our fleet capacity and youth enrollment numbers, and it will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. A Boys & Girls Club branded bus picks up youth members at select bus stops in the cities of Pawtucket and Central Falls. Transportation may also be provided to take Teens home at the end of the program day using select bus stops throughout the cities depending upon availability. # **Parking Policy**

All visitors to the Club **must** follow our parking rules for the safety of all Club members and guests. When a family arrives at the Club, they will park their cars in the designated parking lot. Vehicles are prohibited from parking/stopping on the hill, or any other areas. There are two Club entrances, one located at the Pre-Teen Center and the other located at the bottom of the hill at our Teen Center. Parents/Guardians should accompany their child to the appropriate entry door. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in removal from the program. Thank you for abiding by our Parking Policy and for doing your part to keep all Club members safe.

# **Late Pickup Policy**

A Late Pickup Charge of \$1.00 per minute incurs for each child picked up after 6:30pm for the Pre-Teen program and 8pm for the Teen program. We reserve the right to suspend your child from the Club, and/or remove them from the program, after the THIRD occurrence of late pick-up or if late fees remain unpaid.

# **Program Registration Fees**

Tuition is based on enrollment and not attendance. Unless the Club is notified, as stated in the "Absence from the Program" policy below, you will be charged in full for any weeks in which you are enrolled, regardless of your attendance.

# **Absence from the Program:**

If your child is going to be absent from the program, it is required that you notify the Club in writing 2 weeks in advance. All deposits and memberships are non-refundable. Thank you for your cooperation in regards to this policy.
