SUMMER 2023 PROGRAM ROUNDUP

The Boys & Girls Club of Pawtucket had an absolutely unforgettable summer. Between Camp Ramsbottom, Teen programs, and our summer athletics, this summer was truly one for the books.

Camp Ramsbottom

Children and staff from several communities across Rhode Island and Southeastern Massachusetts came together to have a fantastic summer at Camp Ramsbottom! We all had so much fun, made many



new friends, and tried all sorts of new activities. We were able to have 1,667 local children spend their summer with us at Camp and were able to provide 158 incredible summer experiences to kids who otherwise would not have been able to attend Camp.

While Camp was "out of season," we received an incredibly generous donation of time, materials, and labor to completely renovate our outdoor amphitheater at Camp, called Shoshone Village.



The newly renovated Shoshone Village features ample, comfortable seating, a large beautiful stage, and the wooden stairs have been replaced with a wide and modern gentle path that is accessible for all campers and guests. Thank you so much to all who made this beautiful new space possible! We were able to have some fantastic talent shows, camp fires, awards ceremonies, and more.



Teen Summer Program

This year's Teen Summer Program might have been the best one yet. We had 76 local teens spend their summer here at the Club. Thanks to a partnership with the Pawtucket School Department we were able to welcome 24 students from Slater Middle School to attend our Teen Summer Program at no cost.

Our Teen Center staff planned an incredible event-filled summer for our teens, including field trips to the beach, paintball, bowling, Helix eSports, college campuses, as well as cooking classes, trivia, gardening, dance, games, lunch, summer basketball league, art, and more.

Aquatics

We are incredibly grateful to our wonderful swim staff, because of their hard work and dedication we are proud to have a thriving year-Aguatics Program. round summer we had 13 children learn how to swim at the Club, we also 29 children receive scholarships for swim lessons (up from 8 last summer), enabling them to continue to grow and improve as swimmers.
